ATTENTION: DISTRICTS, CLUBS AND TEAM OFFICIALS

RE: DISCPLINE LEVY FORMAT

Please be informed that in order to cut down on the number of discipline hearings due to the number of teams involved in the one-league, the BCCSL Discipline Committee will endeavor to levy a specific number of games for red card offenses whereby the team official and his player does not have to attend a hearing unless there are extenuating circumstances.

Penalties will be levied as per the following:

Denies obvious Goal – Automatic one (1) game – doesn't need to attend a hearing **Second Caution in the same game** – Automatic one (1) game – doesn't need to attend a hearing **Serious foul play** – one (1) to two (2) games depending on the details provided by the game official.

Anything that is deemed to be of a serious nature will require the player to attend a hearing. **Violent Conduct** – two (2) to three (3) games, anything that is deemed to be of a serious nature, the player will be requested to attend a hearing

Offensive, Insulting, Abusive Language and/or Gestures:

If "directed at no one in particular" – Automatic one (1) game – doesn't have to attend a hearing If this player is reported for language a second time he will then be expected to attend a hearing.

If the language was directed at "another player, team official or spectator" after consideration by the Committee the player will be levied one (1) to two (2) games or may be requested to attend a hearing.

Persistent Protests Against the Decisions of the Referee or Assistants – one (1) to two (2) games.

If the language, which may have included gestures, was abusive and/or insulting and was directed at the referee – the player will be required to attend a hearing.

<u>Please note</u>: The team official has the right to request a hearing within 48 hours of the notice if they disagree with the number of games levied but bear in mind that the indicated number of games are within the parameters of the BC Soccer Discipline Sanction Policy
